The TSLI Pathways

Program provides housing and support services in the community to individuals diagnosed with mental illness. Staff work with the residents on a variety of areas designed to promote skills needed to live more independently such as money management, medication management, community integration and symptom management.

TSLI Pathways has two components:

- Supervised Living Program where staff are on-site 24/7
- Apartment Program where staff are available on-site throughout the day and on-call after hours

Each component is designed to build on an individual's strengths while providing each resident with services developed to promote independence in a safe and nurturing environment.



The TSLI Summit

Program provides Supported
Housing to chronically homeless
families and individuals with a
diagnosis of mental illness.
Residents are visited in their
homes at least weekly, and as
needed.



The TSLI Special Employment
Program (SEP) provides supported
employment opportunities to
individuals with a Serious and
Persistent Mental Illness (SPMI).
Participants are supplied with
support and benefits advocacy to
assist them with maintaining
employment.
